Hello, my name is Andy. I am excited to announce that J.R. Banna & Associates will now be installing a LAN (Local Area Network) in your building. We will also be providing access to High Speed Internet through the LAN.

We will be implementing this building upgrade in a couple different ways:

First we will install a WIFI system which will cover the entire building and surrounding area with wireless internet. This will allow you to use your computer anywhere in the near vicinity wirelessly. We intend to have this system running within the next 2 weeks.

Q+A

Q. Does this affect my current internet connection in any way?

Nope, but it will give you another option if yours happens to go down or slow down.

Q. What equipment will I need for the wireless network?

If your laptop is less than 2 years old, it is possible that there is a wireless card installed already. Wireless adapters for computer systems range in price based on power and capability generally from \$40 to \$130.

Q. Do I need a phone line or a cable modem for this service?

No. But you will need a wireless adapter for the WIFI system, and the power line system has a specific adapter as well.

<sup>1</sup>Note: For those of you who may not know about the Internet Exchange, there is soon to be a co-operative effort to interconnect some of Missoula's internet providers to one another in a central downtown building where many providers lease space. This interconnection will mean that traffic destined to another person in Missoula will stay in town rather than going out to another major city first.

“The Seattle Internet Exchange (SIX) was originally established in April 1997 as a private interconnection between two ISP's in Seattle's Westin building, whose traffic was traveling from Seattle to Texas and back just to cross from one side of the floor to the other.”<http://www.seattleix.net>)
